Dr. Amara Nkosi, a scholar of digital governance at the University of Cape Town, warns of a “platform sovereignty trap,” where states become locked into proprietary systems that prioritize efficiency over equity, reinforcing existing inequalities. “When health becomes a platform rather than a right,” she argues, “the state ceases to represent its people and begins to serve the interests of those who control the code.” Yet proponents, including senior officials in several G20 nations, maintain that RCH is not about control, but about resilience. In a world of recurring pandemics, climate shocks, and cyber threats, they argue, fragmented governance is obsolete. The RCH model, they say, enables rapid, coordinated

responses—deploying AI to predict outbreaks, blockchain to track vaccines, and data analytics to allocate resources efficiently. It is, in their view, a necessary evolution, not a surrender of democracy. The controversies surrounding RCH are multifaceted. Legal scholars highlight the lack of transparency in decision-making algorithms used to allocate health resources, raising concerns about bias and accountability. Privacy advocates point to systemic failures in data protection, where weak encryption and unclear consent protocols expose millions to exploitation. Civil society coalitions have staged global protests, demanding independent audits and public referenda before further rollout. Perhaps most contentious is the role of intelligence agencies: investigative reports have revealed that in multiple countries, RCH-linked platforms include embedded surveillance capabilities, used not only for public health but also for social monitoring and political control.
