Critics argued this deepened media polarization, while supporters cited improved journalistic standards. The ambiguity reflects a broader trend: in emerging democracies, foreign consultants like Opel often provide technical expertise, yet their embeddedness raises questions about sovereignty and cultural authenticity. Economically, Opel's strategies mirrored the neoliberal imperative—concentration, efficiency, shareholder value—applied not just to corporations but to information ecosystems. By bundling content, distribution, and advertising, he helped create vertically integrated media empires that dominate attention economies.
