This shift demands new urban policies: zoning reforms, portable social services, and digital identity systems that recognize temporary residency. Cities must also confront the normalization of surveillance in these spaces—how data collected on guest behavior shapes access, insurance, and even creditworthiness. Scholars and practitioners increasingly view the room washu not as a marginal oddity but as a harbinger of future urban living. Its evolution will reflect broader societal choices: whether to reinforce exclusion through unregulated informality or to harness its adaptive potential through inclusive governance. The room washu, in its quiet persistence, reminds us that behind every shelter lies a story of mobility, negotiation, and survival—one that continues to shape the pulse of global cities.
