Yet the very openness that empowers also introduces new vulnerabilities and ambiguities.

Geopolitically, the proliferation of free CDA-style assessments reflects a strategic contest over digital sovereignty. In the post-2014 era, cyber capabilities have become central to state power. Nations from the Global South to OECD members increasingly view cybersecurity not merely as defense, but as a lever of economic competitiveness and geopolitical influence. This divergence reveals a deeper tension: while free tools promote inclusion, they also embed the assumptions and priorities of their originators, potentially shaping national frameworks according to external paradigms. The result is a fragmented ecosystem. In OECD countries, free CDA tools often integrate with national certification schemes—such as the UK's Cyber Essentials or Germany's IT-Grundschutz—enhancing their credibility. In fragile states or low-income regions, however,

reliance on external free tools risks dependency, as local capacity to adapt or sustain them remains underdeveloped. The OECD’s 2023 report warns that without parallel investment in human capital and institutional infrastructure, free assessments risk becoming symbolic rather than substantive.
