These are not isolated incidents but symptoms of systemic neglect, where rivers become battlegrounds of class, race, and governance. The risks are profound. Climate change accelerates hydrological extremes: floods destroy lives, droughts spark conflict. Water scarcity threatens food security across Africa, the Middle East, and South Asia. In the Mississippi Delta, land loss due to subsidence and sea-level rise accelerates displacement. Yet these crises also spark innovation. In Senegal, community-led mangrove restoration revives natural flood defenses. In Kenya, satellite monitoring empowers pastoralists to track water sources.
