As artificial intelligence, biotechnology, and climate crisis redefine the human condition, the questions he posed—What is real? What is good? Where does meaning come from?—are becoming existential imperatives. *The Reason for God* anticipated this shift by framing faith not as an escape from reality, but as a deeper engagement with it. Its legacy lies not in converting individuals overnight, but in fostering a generation of thinkers and believers capable of holding multiple truths: the scientific and the spiritual, the rational and the mysterious, the historical and the eternal. Keller's project thus stands as a model for how faith can evolve without losing its core—remaining faithful to tradition while speaking urgent truths of the present.
