'Between those who seek to obscure and those who strive to illuminate. The outcome won't be decided by individual courage alone—but by whether societies choose to invest in truth as a public good.' Lawson concluded with a defining insight: 'Journalism is not obsolete. It's evolving. The question is whether we, as citizens, will recognize its value deeply enough to sustain it.'
