Students from Kathmandu's middle-class enclaves scored 30% higher on average than those from marginalized indigenous communities in the Mid-Western Development Region. Dropout rates spiked in districts affected by climate-induced displacement and post-conflict trauma, further entrenching cycles of exclusion. The results also exposed a paradox: despite increased enrollment (net gain of 1.2 million students since 2015), actual learning outcomes had stagnated, indicating a crisis not of access but of quality.

Some policymakers and conservative educators dismissed the results as politically motivated, accusing reformists of “dismantling tradition.” This friction revealed deeper ideological divides—between preservation and progress, central control and local autonomy—that would shape reform debates for years.

Controversies and Risks: Trust, Transparency, and Social Cohesion The release triggered immediate controversy. Opposition parties accused the government of “weaponizing” the results to discredit rivals, pointing to delayed data dissemination and selective disclosure of low-performing schools.
