often for commercial profiling. As investigative journalist and technologist Evgeny Morozov observed, “The vowel-consonant drill, once a humble classroom tool, now lives in infinite loops of behavioral tracking—its simplicity a veneer for systems of control.”

In emerging economies, mobile-first platforms brought phonics to remote areas. In rural Kenya, the “Phonics Pathways” app, using vowel-consonant grids, reached 2 million children, backed by NGOs and government partnerships. But access disparities persisted. In India’s Bihar, 60% of rural schools still lacked tablets; worksheets remained the primary medium.
