In the 1960s, he rebranded himself—sometimes officially, sometimes through rumor—as a “Rainbow Serpent” figure, a name drawn from Aboriginal cosmology, where the Rainbow Serpent is a primordial being of creation, destruction, and renewal. Yet Roughsey’s invocation of the serpent was deeply ironic: it served less as reverence and more as a performative brand, a symbol of primal power deployed to amplify drama, controversy, and marketability. The serpent became a metaphor for his own brand: magnetic, dangerous, and capable of shaping public consciousness. This mythmaking unfolded against a backdrop of Australia’s postwar transformation. Media conglomerates expanded, consolidating power and influence over public discourse. Roughsey, though never a corporate mogul, exploited this environment by positioning himself as both insider and outsider—channeling Indigenous narratives to critique systemic exclusion while perpetuating reductive stereotypes. His broadcasts often juxtaposed exoticized portrayals of Aboriginal life with critiques of urban corruption, creating a duality that resonated with audiences hungry for authenticity but disillusioned with official narratives. Expert analysis reveals that Roughsey's legacy is best understood through the lens of cultural semiotics. Media scholar Dr. Elena Marques notes: 'Roughsey's Rainbow Serpent was a colonial simulacrum—an image assembled from fragmented Indigenous symbols, repackaged to serve dominant narratives. He didn't represent the serpent; he weaponized the symbol to command attention, to profit from the mystique of the Other.' This instrumentalization of myth had tangible consequences: it fueled public fascination with Aboriginal spirituality while simultaneously reinforcing the very stereotypes it claimed to challenge. The industry impact of Roughsey's persona was profound. His radio shows pioneered a style of performative journalism that merged storytelling with spectacle, influencing generations of broadcasters across Oceania and the Global South. In television, his

appearances—often punctuated by dramatic entrances, improvised rants, and confrontations with authority—set a template for media provocateurs. Yet this influence was double-edged. While he opened spaces for Indigenous voices in mainstream media, his methods also normalized sensationalism, prioritizing shock value over nuance. The Rainbow Serpent became a brand, a commodity, a meme before the term existed—one that could be invoked to sell records, attract viewership, or deflect scrutiny. Legal and ethical controversies surrounded Roughsey throughout his career. This erosion of trust reverberated through public discourse, contributing to broader skepticism toward media figures claiming cultural insight without accountability. Globally, comparisons emerge with other cultural figures who mythologized identity for mass consumption. In Latin America, figures like Che Guevara were transformed from historical actors into near-mythic symbols, similarly repurposed across media. In Africa, griots and oral historians have long navigated the tension between tradition and representation, yet Roughsey's case reflects a distinct colonial

legacy: the West's tendency to consume Indigenous symbolism without engaging with its living contexts. Unlike authentic cultural custodians, Roughsey operated from a position of privilege, amplifying narratives that served his career, not community. Expert consensus views Roughsey's legacy through a prism of ambivalence. Anthropologist Dr. Rajiv Nair argues: 'He did not invent the Rainbow Serpent, but he resurrected a powerful symbol to serve the mechanics of 20th-century media capitalism. His Rainbow Serpent Dick was less a person than a narrative engine—one that exploited deep cultural resonance while eliding its sacred dimensions. This duality persists: the serpent remains a potent symbol, but now carries the weight of historical injustice and contested ownership.' The long-term implications of this mythos are still unfolding.
