The **diwata**, for instance, were said to dwell in underwater caves or sunken war canoes, watching over the balance between human activity and marine abundance. Anthropological studies, particularly those by scholars like Atty. Maria Tan in the Philippines and Dr. Siti Nuraeni in Sulawesi, reveal that these beliefs were not passive reverence but active ecological regulation. Taboos against overfishing, seasonal closures, and ritual prohibitions against disturbing certain zones functioned as early conservation mechanisms. The sea was not a resource to be conquered, but a living entity with agency. This worldview persisted despite waves of religious transformation—Hindu-Buddhist kingdoms, Islamic sultanates, and later Spanish and Dutch colonial rule—each layer reshaping but not erasing the core animist ethos.

The Colonial and Postcolonial Shift: Marginalization and Resilience

The arrival of colonial powers fundamentally disrupted this equilibrium. Spanish missionaries, in particular, framed indigenous sea spirits as demonic forces—pagan obstacles to salvation. In the 16th century, Jesuit records from Cebu and Manila documented violent suppression of rituals, destruction of sacred groves near the coast, and forced conversion of fishermen who continued to consult ancestral spirits before voyages. What began as spiritual colonization evolved into a broader epistemic violence: local knowledge systems were delegitimized, and the ocean's mysteries were reframed through Western scientific rationalism. Yet, resilience persisted.
