In rural India, variants speak of cows or chickens built from straw huts, facing tigers or village bandits. In parts of sub-Saharan Africa, the rhyme adapts to include mud-brick homes threatened by storms or raids. These global versions underscore a universal human experience: the vulnerability of the home, a primary site of safety and identity. But the rhyme’s power lies in its adaptability. In post-colonial nations, it has been reclaimed as a metaphor for resilience against systemic oppression. In Latin America, where informal settlements (“barrios”) often face eviction and environmental hazards, the wolf symbolizes

not just natural predators but corrupt officials, speculative developers, or state neglect.
