Yet proponents counter that without rigorous benchmarks, accountability collapses—schools might lack incentives to improve. The tension between measurement and meaning is acute. Globally, the SBAC model has influenced policy beyond the U.S. In India’s National Assessment Project and Brazil’s Prova Brasil, performance-based frameworks increasingly incorporate SBAC’s emphasis on analysis and synthesis. However, cultural adaptation remains critical: systems in collectivist societies often prioritize group learning and oral traditions, challenging SBAC’s individualistic, text-heavy format. This divergence underscores a fundamental debate: can Western-designed assessments be meaningfully applied across diverse educational philosophies without dilution or distortion?
