'The B2 level signals not just language knowledge, but the ability to contribute immediately—drafting reports, leading meetings, navigating cross-cultural feedback,' she explains. Similarly, the German Chamber of Commerce highlights Telc B2 as a key credential in its 'Language for Business' initiative, which certifies professionals for international assignments. Yet, some educators challenge the overreliance on certification. Dr. Klaus Weber, a sociolinguist at Humboldt University, argues that 'language is lived, not tested.' He notes that B2 scores often fail to account for cultural fluency, emotional intelligence, and adaptive communication—elements critical to real-world success. This perspective underscores a broader tension: while certification provides measurable, portable proof, it risks oversimplifying a profoundly social and contextual skill.

Controversies and Risks: Standardization, Access, and Credential Fatigue

Despite its advantages, the Telc B2 model faces significant scrutiny. One recurring controversy centers on test accessibility. While online delivery expands reach, it assumes digital literacy and infrastructure—barriers for rural

communities, older learners, and low-income populations. A 2023 audit by the European Language Observatory found that B2 test attempts in rural Poland and Bulgaria lagged behind urban centers by over 40%, raising equity concerns.
